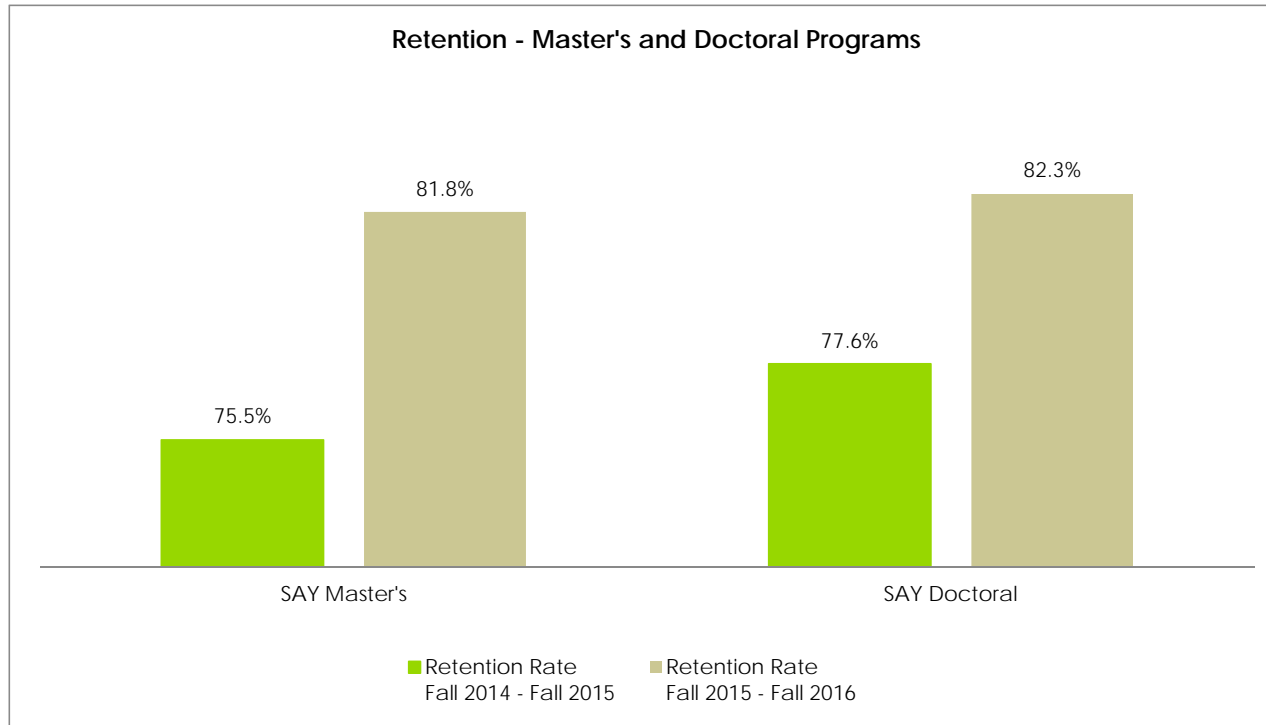

Students who are not active for any reason other than graduation (including, but not limited to, leaves of absence and withdrawal) are not retained.

For the purposes of this institutional level retention report students are counted as retained or graduated if they remained enrolled in or graduated from any program at Saybrook University.
